Montana Snowbowl is a regional destination ski area near Missoula. The area attracts extreme skiers because of the vertical drop of 2,600 feet, but there are a variety of runs to provide skiing for all skiing levels. The drive time between Missoula and the Snowbowl parking lot is approximately thirty minutes. Snowbowl offers 950 lift-served skiable acres on three mountains, lifts are built on two peaks connected by skiable saddles and is served by two high capacity double lifts – so the lines are short and your skiing time is long with long runs, vertical drops, and outstanding views!

Missoula is known as the “Garden City” because of its’ milder winter weather and for its dense trees and lush urban landscape. It is located in the heart of the Rockies of Western Montana. The forested mountain setting has five river valleys joining to enhance the stunning scenic vistas. Missoula offers an abundance of recreational opportunities and western hospitality. There are many attractions to visit when you’re not enjoying the skiing at Snowbowl.

Lodging: You may choose from four different lodging facilities: Ruby’s Inn, the Comfort Inn, the Holiday Inn Express, the Eagle Watch B & B, or the Gibson Mansion B & B.

Dinner: Your dinner options include a Steak House, Italian, or a Casino & Sports Bar.
